67 Main St., Kagawong

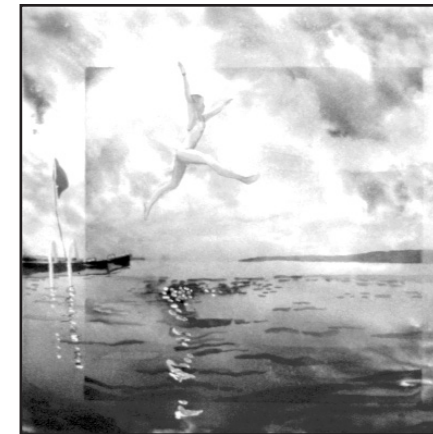

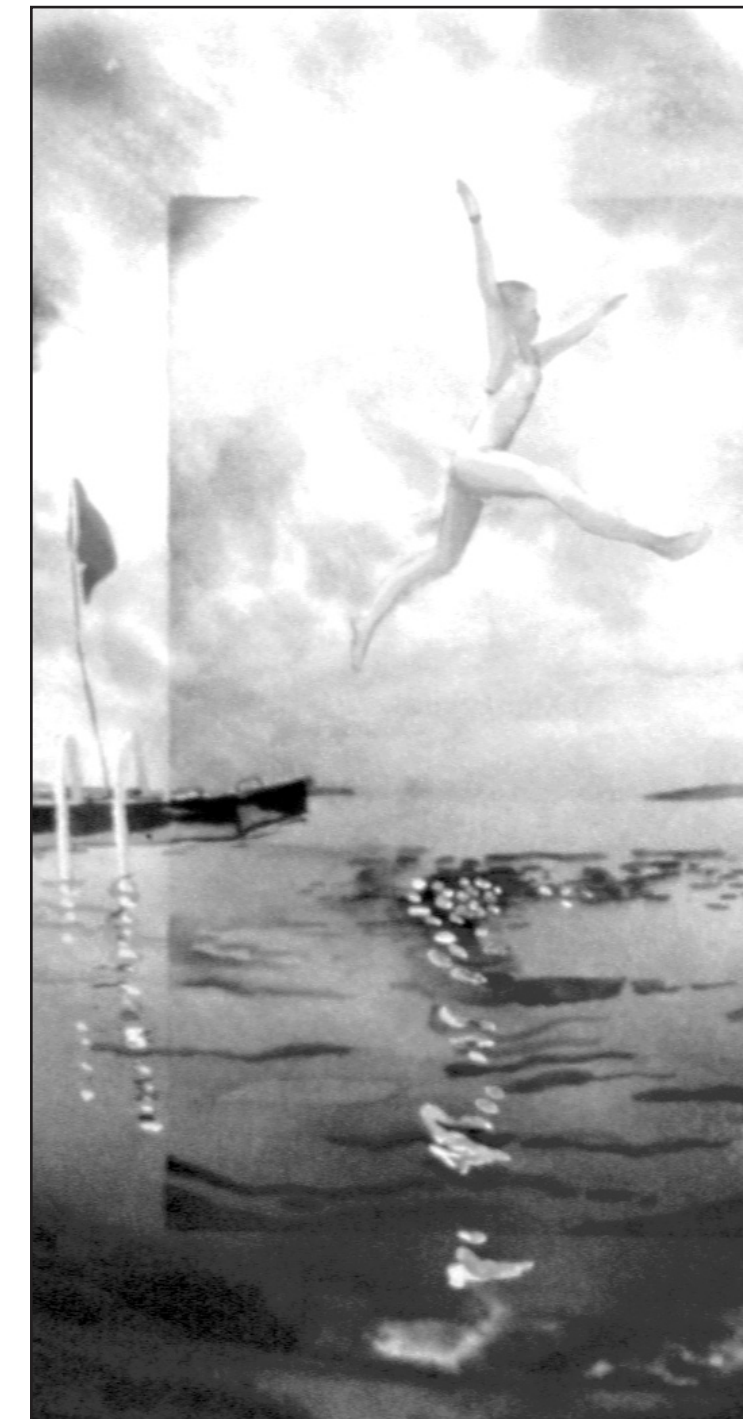
